3:30pm Chairman Wood called the meeting to order.

Review of Claims and Minutes

Commissioners gave an update on the new gates and openers for the maintenance yard.

Sandra reported that there was a slip and fall out at the yard because the snow has not been plowed. She was not injured, but asked if we could get the yard plowed. County needs to get a key to Jarrett Gray.

Discussion on needing more light at the gate, maybe just a small solar light.

Discussion on the condition of the yard and holes could use some fill.

Marc will be on the Idaho Rural Health Association Panel on Tuesday, he will be talking about the Community health programs and any other rural issues.

EMS Bureau is doing a site visit, they are prepared.

CHEMS grant review is well underway and should be approved. Grant has to be allocated by June 30th.

Marc has visited with manufacturers about re-chasis and found out it is just as expensive as it is to buy a new one if we should get a grant to help. He will be working on a grant application for a new ambulance. The grant award would be for \$125,000. The County has \$50,000 set aside and with that it would be enough to purchase another ambulance.

Commissioners reported that our Representative Sally Toone will be putting forward legislation again to raise the ambulance levy limit from .04 to .06 mils.

Commissioner Hubert made a motion to pay the claims for \$5,476.86. Commissioner Ellis seconded. Vote unanimous in favor, motion carries.


Commissioner Ellis made a motion to accept the minutes for January 22, 2019 with changes as noted. Commissioner Hubert seconded. Vote unanimous in favor, motion carries.

Discussion on having new licensed EMT's coming on as a 3rd rider and volunteers. Chairman Wood will check with ICRMP.
