

Planning and Zoning Meeting

March 4, 2019

2:20pm Chairman Wood called the meeting to order.

Review of the address post project and the materials planned to put up the residency addressing sign posts so that is consistent across the Magic Valley for SIRCOMM and emergency responders.

Review of materials.

Guy shared drafts and grids for discussion of a procedure for putting out the address posts. There are just under 1,000 county addresses.

Discussion on the materials that would work best for the signs, the Highway Districts don't feel that the vinyl license plates will hold up in the cold weather and snow plows. They suggest we go to aluminum signs. Will need to see what we can find.

Chairman Wood asked the Highway Districts if they would be willing to help put out the signs. Discussion.

Discussion on the problem of having the correct addresses, agreed that not all addresses are correct even in the Assessors records.

Discussion on where to place the posts. Highway Districts prefer 25' from the center of the road.

Mary noted that it will be critical that all the Highway road signs are up and marked for emergency services, because these posts will only contain the house number.

Highway Districts were asked to look and see what would be a good distance from the center of the road. There will always be some variances.

Assessor Jones can give out grid maps for groups to put up.

Will need 3" letters and a 14" blank. Posts need to be 4' tall about the ground. And it was decided that they will be set 25' from the center of the road, flexible due to obstacles.

The goal to have them all up will be by the end of the summer.
