Minutes & Claims

Chairman Wood read the minutes into the record for discussion and approval.

Commissioner Ellis asked if all the employees have passed their physicals. The answer was yes, all of the full-time employees have taken it and passed.

Sandy reported the classes for advanced will begin again on June 13, 2020 and will go every other weekend for six weeks.

The Stuff the Bus Food Drive on Friday and Saturday at Sawtooth Market was very successful. The bus was loaded and money donations were given. Hygiene kits is something that is needed
