

# LINCOLN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MINUTES

## Emergency Meeting

July 10, 2020

**Present: Rebecca Wood, Chairman; Roy Hubert, Commissioner, by phone; Rick Ellis, Commissioner, by phone.**

**3:30pm** Chairman Wood called Commissioner Hubert, Clerk Farnworth called Commissioner Ellis and the meeting was called to order.

Chairman Wood was contacted by the Family Mart, LLC in Richfield because their beverage license had expired on June 30, 2020 and the Clerk's office had notified them that they did not have a county license to sell beer and must cease until they obtain their county license. The Family Mart is a new business and they were concerned about losing sales over the weekend because there was a ranch rodeo scheduled in Richfield. There was also one other business that hadn't renewed their license and they were notified as well. Both business came into the Clerk's office today and got their paperwork done to renew their license. They just needed the Commissioners to approve.

Discussion on what happened.


**Chairman Wood made a motion to approve the beverage licenses for Family Mart LLC and Main Street Bar and Grill LLC. Commissioner Ellis seconded. Discussion; Clerk Farnworth informed the Commissioners that both business were notified of the need to renew their licenses with two different letters and a phone call. Finally, today the Clerk had her deputy call these business and notify them they did not have a county license and could not sell liquor. Commissioner Ellis noted that if he had known that we wouldn't have seconded the motion. Chairman Wood reminded them that the Family Mart is a new business and this could be detrimental to them to lose sales this weekend. Vote: Commissioner Hubert, yes; Chairman Wood, yes; Commissioner Ellis, no. Motion passed**

**Note: it was later found that it was not the Main Street Bar and Grill LLC that needed the license, but the Main Stop in Shoshone.**

3.45pm Chairman Wood adjourned the meeting.
