

## Step 2 - Check Your Name Tips/Need to Know

- If your Social Security Card does not match your current legal name, you will need to contact the Social Security Administration at 1-800-772-1213.
- If you have your US Passport and it lists your current legal name, no other documentation is needed to prove your name. You will still need to provide your Social Security Number and two Proofs of Residency.
- In case of marriage and a name change, a birth certificate and marriage license are required to show how the name changed. Please note a memorial token certificate is not an acceptable document (this is the bride and groom's copy given at the marriage).
- In the event of divorce, your name may revert back to your maiden name through a court ordered document. Your name must match your social security card.
- If you remarry you will need a birth certificate, divorce decree and any other name change documents. If your current marriage certificate includes your birth name, no additional documents are needed.
