Idaho Department of Lands Fire Program with Lincoln County EMS

James discussed the program, how the EMS will be paid, and how it will be reimbursed,

The employees will be paid at regular rate then, when the County is reimbursed, the employees will be paid the balance due them.

Clerk Farnworth stated she will need to know when the employee is trained and when they will be sent out to a fire. Discussion on the fund lines and what will be expensed

Chairman Wood made a motion to allow the Lincoln County EMS to contract with Idaho Department of Lands to assist on fires. Commissioner Hubert seconded. Vote unanimous in favor, motion carries.

Clerk Farnworth presented the 2nd Quarter expense and revenue reports for discussion. Discussion on payroll and more overtime than usual because of being short staffed, workman's comp, the A & D budget is a little high; the total expense is at 54%.


Discussion on revenue; it is at 44.7%. Discussion on the on CHEMS. Overall, everything looks good.

Discussion on the CHEMS program. Events to promote more screenings for the program are Arts in the Park, Fair, and the Youth Center programs. CHEMS is a program to help residents keep up on the medical needs for patients.


