Ambulance District Meeting

November 8, 2021

Commissioner Hubert made a motion to pay the November 8, 2021 Ambulance District accounts payable for \$7,126.33. Commissioner Rutler seconded. Vote unanimous in favor, motion carries.

Commissioner Rutler made a motion to pay the November 8, 2021 Ambulance District Fire accounts payable for \$1,615.21. Commissioner Hubert seconded. Vote unanimous in favor, motion carries.

Commissioner Hubert made a motion to accept the Ambulance District minutes for October 12, 2021 as presented. Commissioner Rutler seconded. Vote unanimous in favor, motion carries.

Discussion on CPR certification and recertification classes needed for Youth Center employees. Recertification classes can be done on National CPR Foundation website.

Discussion on the process of Fire payroll payout and revenue coming in from fires. The agreement is that the Fire payroll will be paid after the revenue from the fires are received. The remaining balance will be used by the Ambulance District. Money from the revenue account will need to be transferred the payroll account to cover the fire payroll that has already been paid out.

Sandy Harner said that Chems and Fire are no longer listed as Job Codes on TimeClock since TimeClock updated their program. This will be fixed.

Sandy Harner asked about a shred bin to destroy files that are past the destruction date. She was told that the county has a shred bin, but a destruction resolution needs to be presented in order to destroy the files.
